
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ENGLISH SOLO - SONG INTER -HOUSE COMPETITION

INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION – 15-08-2021


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


































<u>HINDI SKIT ON SWATCH BHARAT - HOUSEWISE</u> <u>COMPETITION</u>



SCHOOL LEVEL SCIENCE EXHIBITION- 30-09-2021





It was an interesting and encouraging program conducted by teachers as a gift for students on Children's Day.




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


















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CHRISTMAS TREE MAKING COMPETITION (CLASS WISE)


REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION – 26-01-2022








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
