
CBSE HUB OF LEARNING ACTIVITIES 2021-22

TOPIC: METHODOLOGY OF TEACHING (MATHEMATICS)


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

As part of HUB Activity 2021-22, webinar on methodology of teaching in Mathematics was conducted for the teachers of the HUB Schools by Air Force School, Jalahalli. The highlights of the session on "Methodology of teaching (Mathematics)" are summarized below:

- 1. The objective of the workshop was to discuss about the innovative methods of teaching suggested by NEP 2020 with a provision to revamp the teaching learning process.
- 2. NEP 2020 suggest some teaching methodologies that teacher can embrace in teaching learning process. Some of the strategies include Flipped classroom, blended learning, collaborative learning, manipulatives, gamification, Inquiry-Based Learning etc.

- 3. Flipped Classroom It is a methodology of teaching where student reviews the topic using digital learning support and then classroom time is used to apply knowledge on problem solving.
- 4. Tool 1 Nearpod is the interactive instructional program that can be used to incorporate flipped classroom learning. It gives teachers the real insight into student learning understanding through interactive videos and lessons.
- 5. Virtual Manipulatives They are cognitive technological tools that are dynamic visual representation of physical manipulatives that help students to understand abstract mathematical concepts.
- 6. Tool 2 ToyTheatre is a collection of educational virtual manipulatives for elementary and middle school. Children will have fun while developing earth math facts and makes the learning process interesting for the students.
- 7. Gamification It is an educational approach that seeks to motivate the students to learn by using video game elements in learning environment. It aims at maximizing the enjoyment and engagement of students in learning process and to inspire them to continue learning.
- 8. Tool 3 Kahoot is a real-time platform for game based learning that has been widely used in education. It is a student response tool for administering quizzes, facilitating discussions and collecting survey data.
- 10. The workshop was to mainly share details about the various online tools that can be used in innovative teaching practices in Math so as to enhance the teaching-learning process and make it effective in hybrid learning.
