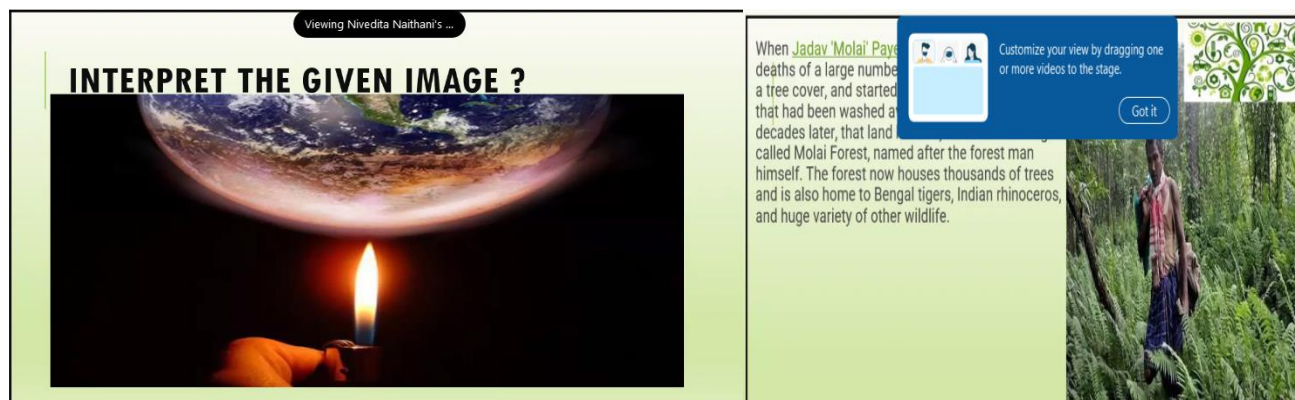


“SALIENT FEATURES OF NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY 2020”

The NEP 2020 is the first education policy of the 21st century and replaces the thirty-four year old National Policy on Education (NPE), 1986. Built on the foundational pillars of Access, Equity, Quality, Affordability and Accountability, this policy is aligned to the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and aims to transform India into a vibrant knowledge society and global knowledge superpower by making both school and college education more holistic, flexible, multidisciplinary, suited to 21st century needs and aimed at bringing out the unique capabilities of each student.

COE Delhi organised a webinar on Environment Education in Practice on 19th June 2021. MS.Nivedita Naithani was the Resource person for the webinar. 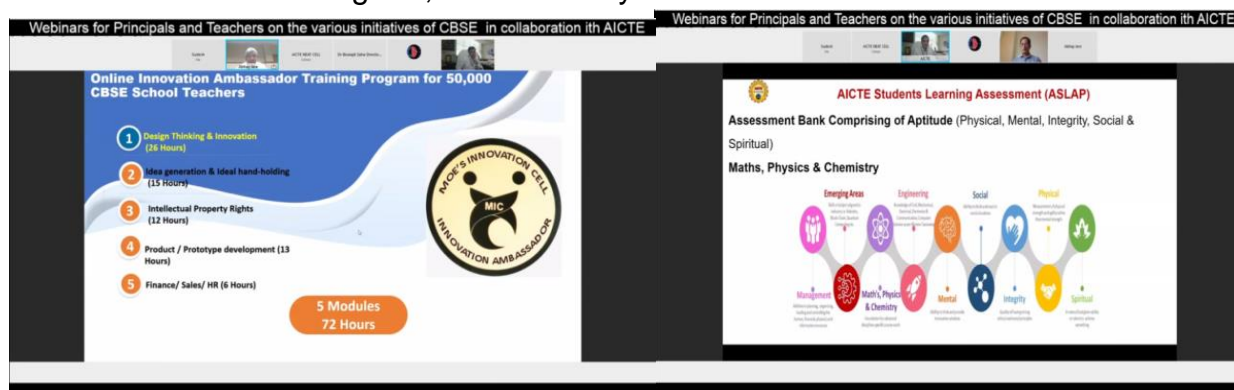
WORKING WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES

INNOVATION AMBASSADOR PROGRAM,

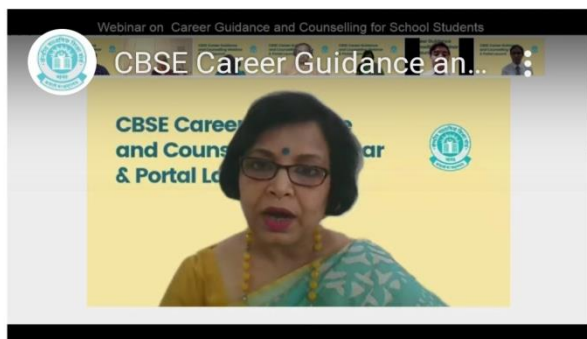

ASSESSMENT REFORMS WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO CBSE SCHEME OF 2021-22

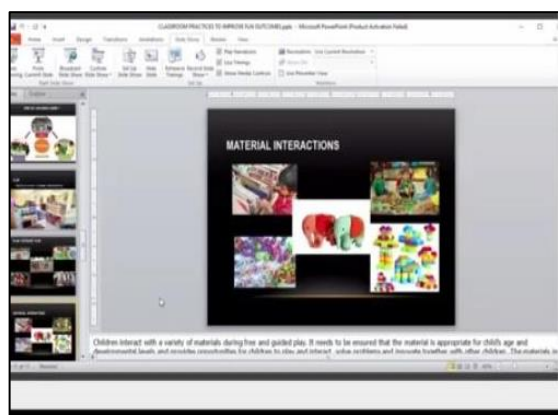

The resource person spoke about understanding the learning gaps to access the students when they join the school back again. Covering those learning gaps will be the top priority of CBSE. He told about the examination patterns that will be followed in the session while giving guidelines for the same. He also spoke about the assessment framework. Basically, about how the exams will be conducted, what type of MCQs will be framed so that it will be easily accessible to students. He also spoke about the components of the internal assessment and about the sample paper design.



FOUNDATIONAL LITERACY AND NUMERACY.

As part of CBSE webinar series a workshop was conducted on 9 Aug 21. The topic of webinar was FOUNDATIONAL LITERACY AND NUMERACY. 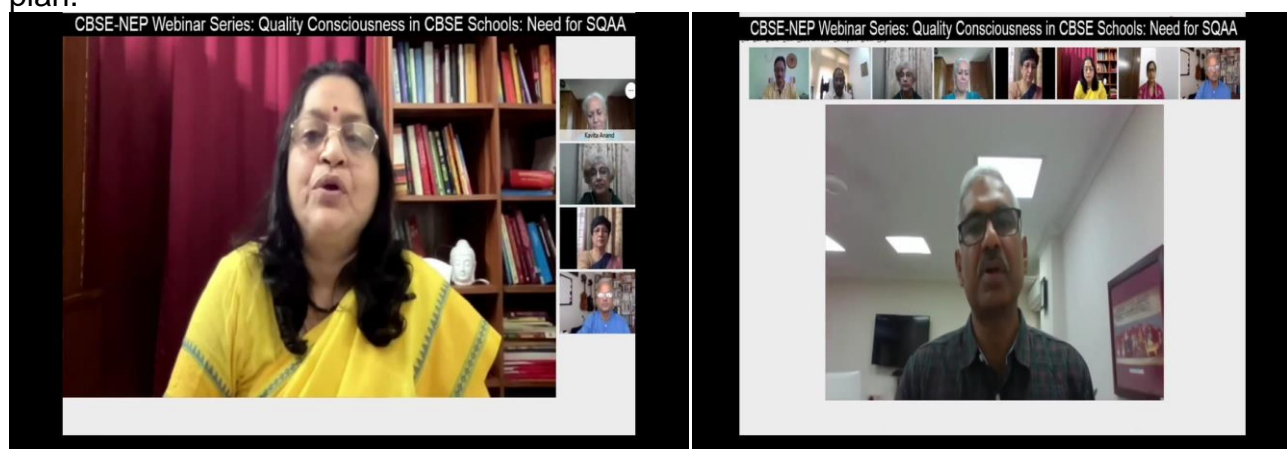
DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION USING NEW TECHNOLOGY

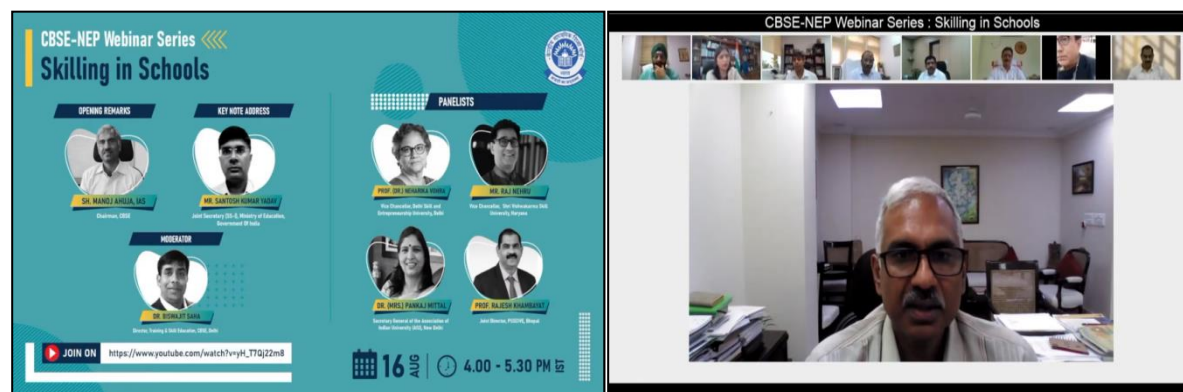
SCHOOL QUALITY ASSESSMENT AND ASSURANCE (SQAA)

NEP WEBINAR SERIES 2021-22: SKILLING IN SCHOOLS

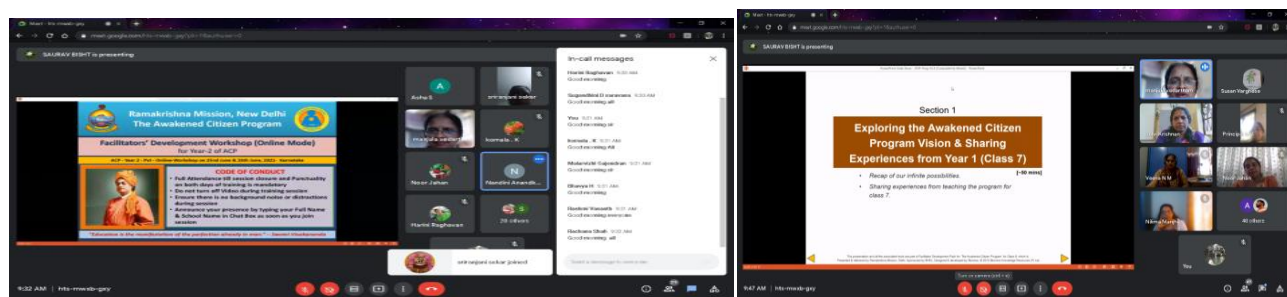

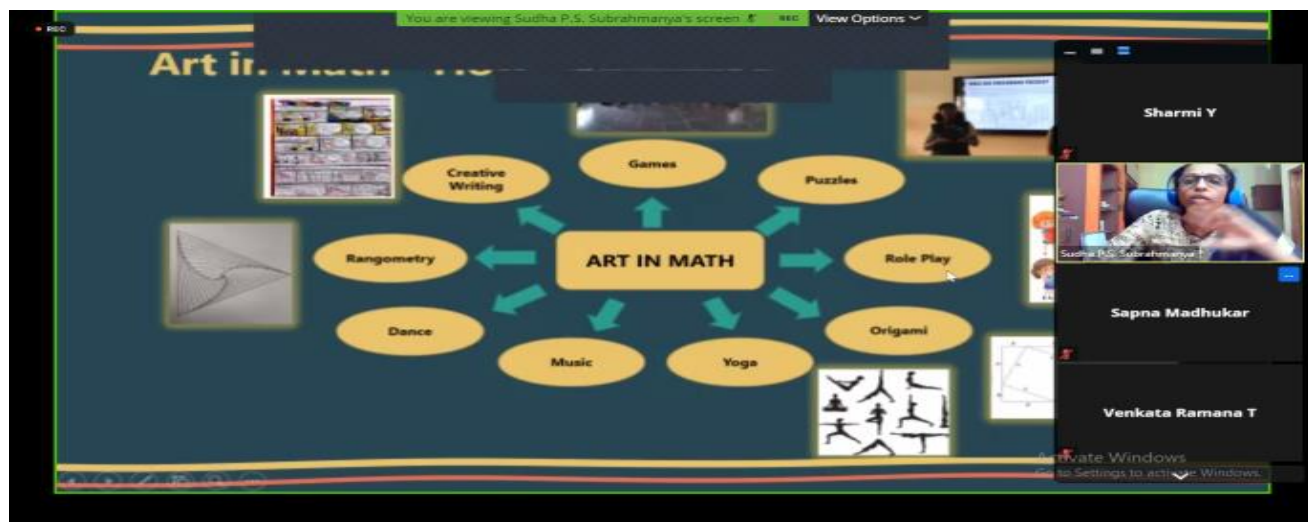
AWAKENED CITIZENSHIP PROGRAMME

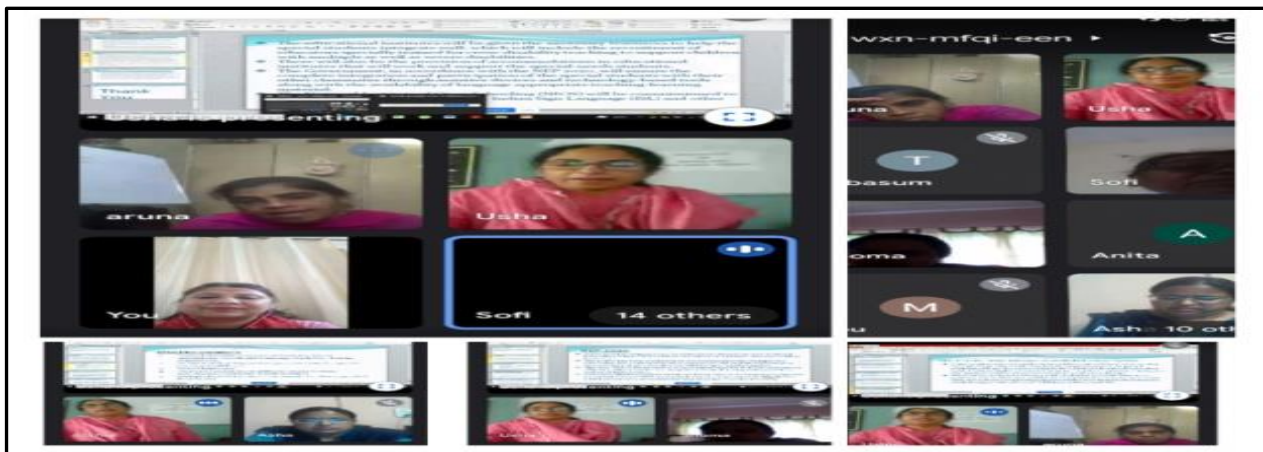
WORKSHOP MUSIC

RPWD Act, 2016

The webinar was conducted by Mrs Usha Joseph, on 3 July for Air Force School staff. The RPWD act helps inclusive education to provide equal and non-discriminating environment to disabled persons in general schools. It discusses the admission, retention and full participation of children with disabilities in educational process which is one of the necessary principles of inclusive education. The Act was a result of India being a signatory of UNCRP and later ratifying it. The main objective behind the Act is to empower persons with disabilities by safeguarding their dignity, freedom to make their own choices, independence and their position in the society. The society tends to alienate the people who have certain disabilities which lead to discrimination and exclusion from the society. With the help of this act, the gap between the society and persons with disabilities can be reduced. The Act aims to achieve equality between persons with disabilities and others, participation of persons with disabilities in any arena, preserving the rights of women and children with disabilities and ensure their human rights.



NUANCES OF ONLINE TEACHING & LEARNING

An Academic forum on Nuances of Online teaching and learning was conducted on July 17, 2021 for all Principals and teachers of Airforce Schools across India. The session began with the justification of the statement if online teaching is a result of pandemic or was it something awaiting to happen?
